MINUTES – PUBLIC HEARING 2023 BUDGET – NOVEMBER 9, 2023

CALL TO ORDER:

At 6:00 pm Mr. Tomaino called the public hearing on the 2024 Budget to order with the pledge of allegiance.

2024 BUDGET:

Mr. Tomaino wanted to discuss A3120.4 Court Security, both Judge Pelon and Judge Simpon spoke to Mr. Tomaino on the hourly rate for Security Officer Gibbs. Both Judges feel Mr. Gibbs should be getting paid what other municipalities are paying for their services which is \$25.00 an hour. This would be an increase to this line of \$800. After discussion board members believe they should leave the rate as originally agreed upon.
